In the following, we will attempt, relying on religious sources and practical experiences of spiritual wayfarers, to shed light on the way to get names and the secrets of this path.

From Perseverance in Worship to Acquiring a Name

After raising the initial concerns and questions, we now want enter the main path step by step and examine the way to get names in practical terms.

The reality is that each of us connects more deeply with certain types of worship that align with our personal character and temperament. On the steep path of self-improvement, we have come to realize that there is no single fixed formula for everyone, but the important principle that is in front of us is the way to get names; that is, finding the act of worship or practice that harmonizes most with our soul and passion, and in the next step, loving continuity and persistence in performing the act is important.

When we honor our choice and continue the act of worship that we love consistently and enthusiastically, that act of worship slowly transforms from a mere external activity into a permanent and inner characteristic. At this stage, the path to acquire divine names is paved for us, leading us to what Islamic philosophy calls acquiring an asset.

Thus, if we are seeking profound growth and transformation in our spiritual path, we should consciously and lovingly apply the way to get names in our lives, and remain determined in choosing and continuing the path of our chosen acts of

worship. Without a doubt, passionate perseverance in the chosen act of worship is the surest path to acquire true spiritual asset and connection with divine names.
